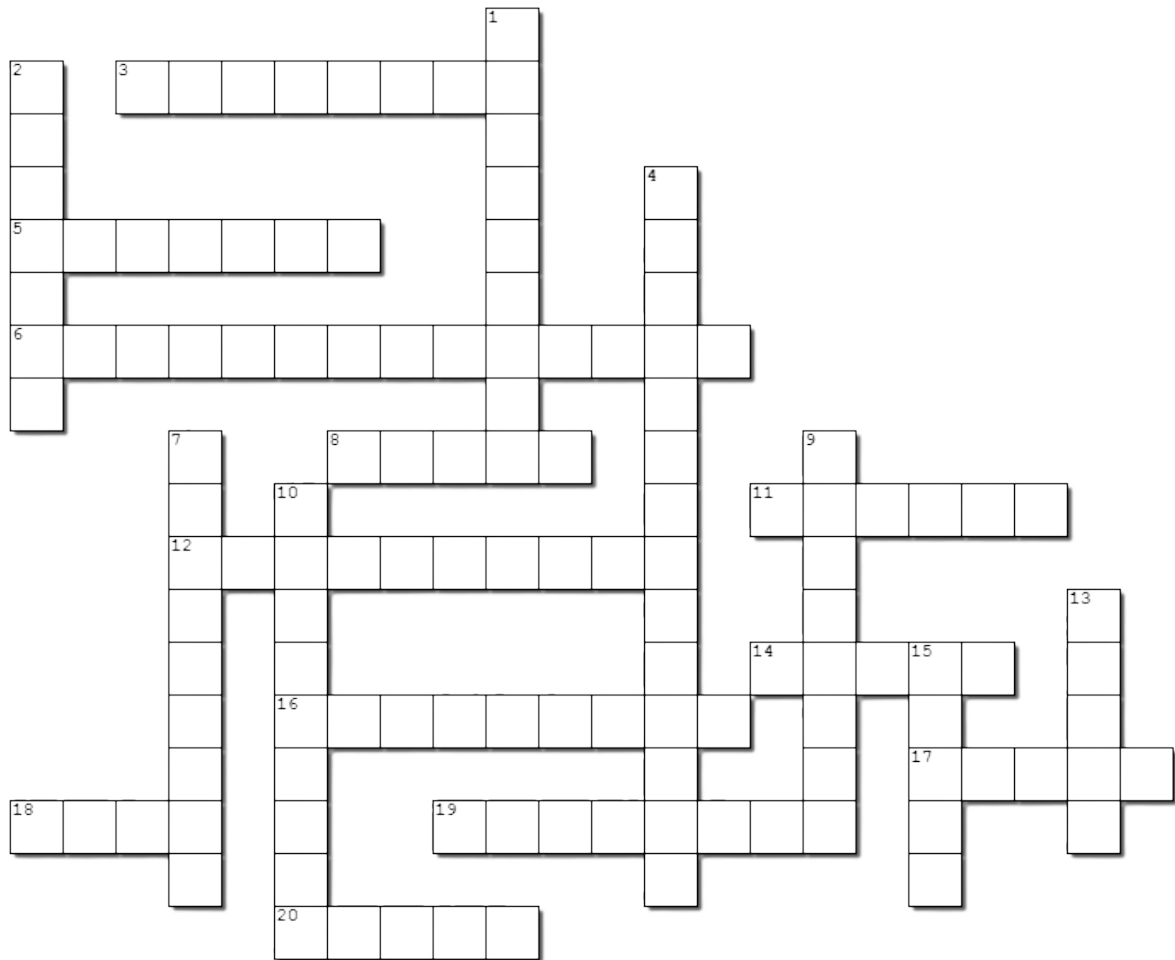


Recycling Crossword
